Dear Prospective Nursery Parent/Carer

30 Hours Free Nursery Provision

You are no doubt aware that all 3- and 4-year-olds in England are currently entitled to free early education for up to 15 hours a week, for 38 weeks of the year. From September 2017, a further 15 hours a week will be paid for by Government for those children whose parent/carer or parents/carers work and live in England, and earn or expect to earn over the coming three months between the equivalent of 16 hours at the minimum wage and £100,000/year.

If your child is eligible for this additional funding, you will need to claim it by obtaining a voucher code from HMRC.

To do this you need to log onto the following web page and follow the instructions:

https://childcare-support.tax.service.gov.uk/par/app/extendedentitlement

To complete this application, you will need:

- your National Insurance number
- your Unique Taxpayer Reference if you are self-employed
- the date you started, or are due to start work, and
- details of any government support you get.

If your child is eligible for the additional 15 hours of funding, you will be provided with an 11 digit voucher code. This can take up to 10 working days, so please apply as soon as possible.

Once you receive your child's voucher code, please forward the code to <u>bachar.aleddin@st-charles.rbkc.sch.uk</u> with your child information as soon as possible, as we are required to verify eligibility.

If your child is not eligible for the additional 15 hours of funding, responsibility for paying £50.00 per week for nursery fees will fall to you.
