The boxes are due back when we return after the School Easter break.

Their focus is to provide support as early as possible. They help vulnerable children overcome the challenges they face so they can achieve their full potential and have hope of a brighter future. They achieve this through a range of services and St Charles School has benefitted many times, over many years, by taking advantage of the following two services

ConnectEd Mental Health Services

Professional counselling and therapy services on-site in over 70 schools. Each year they support hundreds of children who experience issues such as abuse, neglect, domestic violence and family breakdown. They also train school staff, enhancing their skills to identify and support pupils with mental health needs.

Crisis Fund

They operate a Crisis Fund which provides immediate financial support for families facing a crisis in their lives. This support makes a huge difference to families in desperate situations when they have nowhere else to turn.
