Dear Parent/Carer,

This year's Relationships Conference will take place in school on 15th, 16th and 17th June 2022.

In the past, we have been able to take the year 6 children to Buckden Towers, in Cambridgeshire, for the annual relationships conference but this had to stop due to the Covid restrictions. We had hoped to take them away this year but the Centre had not opened in time for us to book it. To make up for this, children may wear their own clothes for the three days and we will keep them until 8pm on Thursday evening to enjoy a film and pizza together.

The themes covered during the conference will be;

Creation, Self-Image, Puberty, Human Reproduction, Marriage/Relationships and Bereavement.

The Conference will end with a liturgy celebrating the end of the course.

There will be a meeting in School on Tuesday 7th June at 3.15pm where we will present the themes in more detail and give you an opportunity to ask questions.

By law, all children must be taught about puberty and how and why their bodies will change during adolescence. However, you do have a choice as to whether or not to allow your child to be taught about Sex Education aspect of the Conference. After the meeting we will be seeking your electronic permission to include them in this session.
