The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved	91% Agree or Strongly Agree 4% Did not know	More parents felt we were dealing with issues better. On the occasions where there may be issues between pupils, our first approach is to try to mediate to ensure the issue can be resolved and the relationship can be repaired. We feel this gives our pupils the skills they need to deal with issues going forward. However, where this is not possible, we will take other steps, including keeping children away from each other.

The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year	89% Agree or Strongly Agree 9% Disagree or Strongly Disagree 2% Don't know	Some parents felt they did not have any information about what children are learning. We send out an outline of what is being taught in each class at the start of every term. Phase meetings were held at the start of the term to outline the curriculum and expectations for the year. The curriculum for each class and for each subject are available on the website. Respondents said we brought out the best in every child and that we tap into individual strengths, that we challenge and stretch children. You said we supported children with SEND well. A small number felt we could do better in this respect. We will continue to ensure we set high expectations for everyone. Please raise any issues with class teachers.

When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly.	15% Had not raised concerns with the school 72% Agree or Strongly Agree 4% Disagreed 9% Did not know	It is good to hear that almost all respondents said that we dealt with issues raised properly. Do continue to contact class teachers or leaders if you have any concerns.

Whilst it is not possible to give weekly, personalised updates on every part of the curriculum every week, teachers are available to discuss progress at any stage of the year. Class emails have been distributed which also provide a method of communicating with teachers. Please make an appointment with your child's class teacher.
The curriculum at the school is engaging, broad and balanced	91% Agree or Strongly Agree 2% Disagreed or Strongly Disagreed 6% Did not know	We continue to plan and adapt the curriculum and trips to ensure they are engaging, broad and balanced. You can follow everything we are doing in school on WEDUC and our social media.

My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school	74% Agree or Strongly Agree 15% Disagreed or Strongly Disagreed 11% Did not know	You felt the school could improve the choice of clubs and activities offered to children, particularly to younger pupils. We have worked to offer a wider range of clubs but unfortunately, due to low take up, these have had to be discontinued as they were not cost effective to run. We are continuing to work on addressing this issue.
The school supports my child's wider personal development	81% Agree or Strongly Agree 11% Disagree or Strongly Disagree 9% Did not know	A small number of respondents also felt we should prioritise personal development more and have more trips. Personal development is a key component of our curriculum. Apart from regular PSHE lessons, we address issues through circle times, discussions and talks. Our International Women's Month, Black History activities and other sessions during the year all support personal development. All classes take part in trips during the year and also in specific workshops in school to support curriculum learning. You can see what is coming up in the calendar on WEDUC.
The school is inclusive and promotes diversity	89% Agree or Strongly Agree 6% Neutral 4% Did not know	We were pleased to see that respondents recognise the work we have done to promote diversity and inclusivity including in our curriculum, trips and guests to school. We have had talks on other religions. We have also invested in improving the diversity in our reading books and the material we use in school to ensure protected characteristics are represented. We are continuing to work with our parents on this area. We continue to work with all our staff to ensure that we deal effectively with any prejudice-related incidents.

However, most respondents said we're doing this well. We understand the need to give everyone enough notice of meetings and events. We have introduced WEDUC to help us further improve communication.
