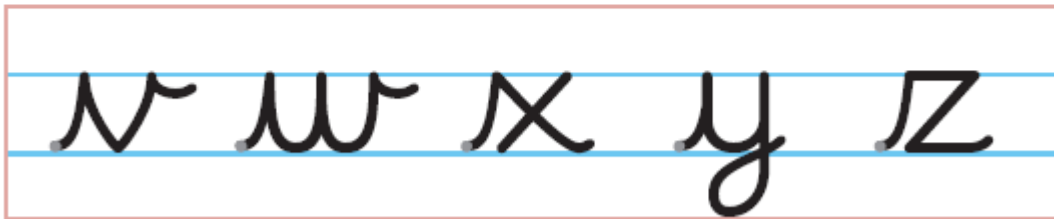
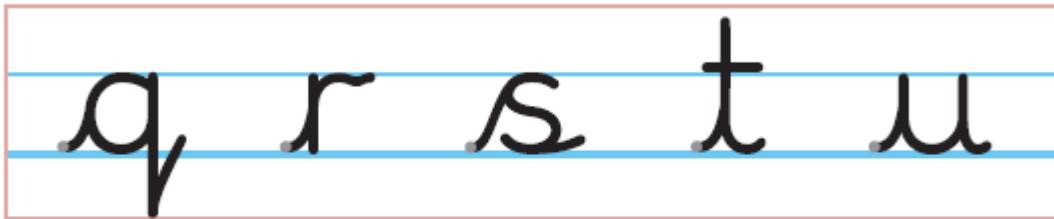
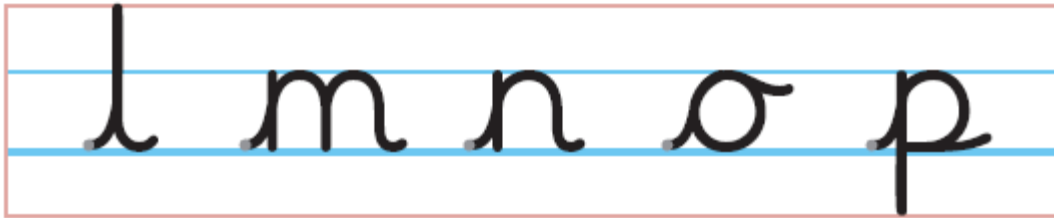


Handwriting in KS2
